- 1. Participate in the LU 2724 Health and Safety committee monthly meeting.
- 2. As a Health and Safety representative for LU 2724 you will be expected to respond to calls after hours in the event of an emergency.
- 3. Participate as resource in the LU 2724 company committee quarterly meeting.

4. Act as Co-chair on committees and subcommittees Attend Monthly Department Meetings, Bi-Monthly Division meetings and Quarterly Steelworks Meetings to represent the LU- and Provide Update to LU 2724 Steelworks Co-Chair and Joint Health and Safety Committee:

You will be expected to participate in regular Health and Safety & House Keeping audits of the areas, reviews of the job safe practices and other requirements of being co-chair.

- 5. Act as a resource for the remainder of the monthly Joint Health and Safety meetings throughout the steelworks. (ex. Plate and Strip Hot Mill, DSPC, Cokemaking, etc.)
- 6. Representative for LU 2724 members regarding occupational disease issues (filing claims for items such as cancer, COPD, hearing loss, etc...)
- 7. Act as an appeal agent with regard to occupational disease claims which have been denied by the W.S.I.B.
- 8. Attend UMC meetings as a resource.
- 9. Investigate work refusals involving members of 2724.
- 10. Attend accident investigations, Near Miss and first treatment meetings involving 2724 members.
- 11. Attend F1-7 meetings involving 2724 members.
- 12. Participate in developing & delivering Safety training packages for 2724 members, including Supervisor training.
- 13. Attend and address LU 2724 issues at departmental off-sites.
- 14. General resource for 2724 members' safety concerns.
- 15. Perform safety over sight on major repair shifts and down days.
- 16. Act as a resource for pre-job safety requirements for down days and rebuilds.
- 17. Develop & deliver monthly report at the General membership meetings.
- 18. Develop a weekly report to be delivered to LU 2724 executive.
- 19. This position will work with LU 2724 Steelworks Co-Chair and report to the President of LU 2724.
