Advanced Welding Skills Program

For experienced or previously certified welders who need individualized support to refresh, requalify, or advance their credentials. Program will be individualized based on participant needs. The program will also include a work placement.

Applied Welding Skills Program

For workers with industrial aptitudes but have limited hands-on welding experience. The program will provide practical, hands-on skills to weld various types of metals, combined with the knowledge and theory needed to be successful in this industry. Program will also include a work placement.

Applied Industrial Mechanics Program

Designed for experienced industrial workers looking to build advanced hands on skills for today's industrial workplaces. Participants will learn how to support the installation, maintenance, repair, and troubleshooting of industrial machinery and equipment. Training includes mechanical systems, equipment setup, safe tool handling, preventive maintenance, and workplace safety practices used across manufacturing, mining, utilities, and other industrial sectors.
